DIGGING UP HISTORY

Archaeologist Tara Giuliano worked yesterday to identify the location of graves at the Freedmen's Cemetery Site in Alexandria. While searching for the graves of about 1,800 former slaves, archaeologists found what they think is a stone tool about 13,000 years old. Until this discovery, the oldest known Alexandria artifact was about 9,000 years old.
