Frequently Asked Questions – FAQ’s

The Chinquapin Park Recreation Center closed for day-to-day operations on Monday June 17, 2013 to facilitate facility improvements. The scope of facility improvements is highly invasive to the structure and interior spaces, necessitating the full closure of the facility. The full closure during the improvement period will ensure public safety, reduce costs and shorten the improvement period. Question (Q): When will construction begin?

Answer (A): June 17, 2013

Q: When will Chinquapin reopen to the Public?

A: November 1, 2013

Q: Will the public be able to use the tennis courts?

A: Yes

Q: Will the entire facility be closed during construction?

A: Yes

Q: Are all the Chinquapin programs and services cancelled during facility improvements?

A: No. In order to minimize inconvenience for our customers, the City has redistributed many of the popular programs to other facilities. Visit www.alexandriava.gov/70502.

Q: Will construction activities impact neighboring T. C. Williams High School?

A: No. Majority of work planned will occur within the facility. Deliveries will be scheduled to avoid conflicts with drop-off/pick-up times.

Q: Will improvement activities result in noise outside the facility?

A: No. Majority of work planned will occur within the facility. Contractors will observe the City’s noise ordinance restrictions during work days.
