2. Approval of the minutes from the July 27, 2009, Traffic and Parking Board Meeting. Ms. Slack made a motion, second by Mr. Cota to approve the minutes of the July, 27, 2009 Traffic and Parking Board meeting. 4. **ISSUE:** Consideration of a recommendation to place the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a taxicab company in the City of Alexandria on probationary status for failure to provide the minimum level of dispatch service required by City Code Section 9-12-33 (c).

**BOARD ACTION:** Mr. Lonnie Rich and Mr. Rick Vogel spoke on the behalf of Alexandria Union Cab Company. Ms. Slack made a motion to reduce Alexandria Union Cab Company Authorization by 40. The motion was seconded by Mr. Posey. The Board voted 4 to 3 to deny the motion, the motion failed. Mr. Ruggiero, Mr. Cota, Mr. Sargeant, Mr. Norwood voted against the motion. Mr. Johnson, Ms. Slack, Mr. Posey voted for the motion . Mr. Ruggiero made a motion to defer the probation until November's meeting, and that two months deferral count toward Alexandria Union Cab Company maximum time to get

in compliance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sargeant. The Board voted 5 to 2 to approve the motion. Ms. Slack and Mr. Posey voted against the motion. Mr. Johnson, Mr. Ruggiero, Mr. Cota, Mr. Sargeant, Mr. Norwood voted for the motion.
