Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB)	Virginia Dept. of Transportation, Dept. of Rail & Public Transportation, Dept. of Aviation, Port of Virginia. Board sets transportation policy and funding priorities for Virginia.	16-Jun	14-Jul	The CTB adopted the Fiscal Years 2011-2016 Six-Year Improvement Program (SYIP) on June 16. The \$7.8 billion SYIP proposes \$5.7 billion for highway construction and \$2.1 billion for rail and public transportation.	Staff provided an oral update on SYIP items of note for Alexandria at the June 2, 2010 meeting of the Transportation Commission. There are no additional updates.
Transportation Planning Board (TPB)	Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. The regional planning body that serves as the federally designated Metropolitan Planning Organization.	16-Jun	21-Jul	The TPG on June 16 approved a regional pre-application to the TIGER II program for funds to be used for bike sharing by the District of Columbia, Arlington County, City of Alexandria, Fairfax County, Montgomery County, and the City of College Park.	Preapplications for TIGER II are due July 16 and final applications are due August 23.
Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA)	Nine cities/counties in NoVa with a 16-member board. Charged with preparing and implementing a regional transportation plan.	13-May	8-Jul	The NVTA did not hold a meeting in June.	To be determined.
Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC)	Manages and controls the functions, affairs, and property of the Northern Virginia Transportation District which is comprised of six member jurisdictions, including Alexandria. NVTC provides a policy forum for its region and allocates state, regional, and federal transit assistance.	1-Jul	2-Sep	The NVTC is moving forward with the TransAction 2030 process and endorsed the TIGER II application.	At the July 7 meeting of the Transportation Commission, staff will provide an oral update on NVTC items of note from its most recent meeting.
Washington Metropolitan Transit Authority (WMATA) Board	Determines agency policy and provides oversight for the funding, operation, and expansion of transit facilities.	24-Jun	22-Jul	WMATA passed a \$1.4 billion operating budget in their Finance and Administration Committee, which relied heavily on a significant fare increase to balance the budget. This budget did not require WMATA to trim its services. WMATA also passed a \$5 billion capital budget.	The capital funding agreement will have significant benefits for Alexandria. It will fund the replacement of the 1000 series railcars, the oldest cars in the WMATA fleet, and will fund a replacement bus garage for the Alexandria Royal Street garage, in Cinder Bed Road, in Fairfax County. Staff will provide additional oral updates on WMATA items of note at the July 7 meeting.
Northern Virginia Regional Commission (NVRC)	Regional council of 14 member governments in Northern Virginia that provides information and serves as a mechanism for regional coordination	24-Jun	22-Jul	June 24 commission meeting cancelled.	To be determined.
